Criteria for Selection

- a. Applicant must be an IEEE member with minimum of 2 years continuous membership
- b. Applicants must be living in and hold citizenship from underserved countries in Africa including Ghana, Kenya, Rwanda, Uganda, Zambia etc.
- c. Applicant should be an engineer or a lecturer in power and energy discipline.
- d. Applicant must be someone who has ability to pass on the conference attendance learning.
- e. Submit a motivation statement or letter describing how you will use this opportunity to create impact in your institution.
- f. In addition to the above, recipients will be selected based on the strength of the motivation statement
